Sec. 16-1. Mayor's Salary Provided.

The salary of the Mayor shall be and the same is hereby fixed at the sum of fifty dollars (\$50.00) per month. (Ord. of 10 Feb., 1964, Sec. 1; For similar State law, see: Code of Alabama, Tit. 37, Sec. 440.)

Sec. 16-2. Mayor's Expenses Provided.

The Mayor shall receive a sum of one-hundred dollars (\$100.00) per month for car expenses, and any other expenses incurred by the Mayor in the course of his services to the Town shall be submitted for payment. (Resolution of 14 April, 1969; For State law regarding fees, expenses, compensation, see: Code of Alabama, Tit.37, Sec. 408-411.)

Sec. 16-3. Councilmen's Salary Fixed.

Each Councilman shall be paid at the rate of five dollars (\$5.00) per meeting for each regular or special meeting attended. (Ord. of 10 Feb., 1964, Sec. 2)

Sec. 16-4. Annual Salary of Treasurer.

The annual salary of the Treasurer shall be established by the Town Council. (Code of Ft. Deposit, 1906, Chap. 14, Sec. 307; For State law authorizing Town to fix salaries of employees, see: Code of Alabama, Tit. 37, Sec. 409.)

Sec. 16-5. Salary of Chief of Police.

The salary of the Chief of Police for the Town shall be established by the Town Council. (Ord. of 14 Feb., 1966.)

Sec. 16-6. Salary of Part Time and Additional Police.

The salary of all part-time and extra police shall be fixed by the Town Council. (Ord. of 14 Feb., 1966.)

Sec. 16-7. Salary of Town Clerk.

The salary of the Town Clerk shall be established by the Town Council. (Ord. of 14 Feb., 1966; see also Code of Alabama, Tit. 37, Sec. 408-411.)

Sec. 16-8. Town Attorney - Fees.

The Mayor may employ an attorney to prosecute or defend any suit brought by or against the Town, and may also, when in his judgment the peace and welfare of the Town demands, employ an attorney to prosecute any person or persons arraigned in the Recorder's Court for the violation of an ordinance, or any other suit to be brought or pending in said court, and such attorney shall receive such compensation or fees as may be approved by the Town Council. (Code of Ft. Deposit, 1906, Chap. 14, Sec. 310.)

Sec. 16-9. Pay Rates for Members of Fire Department.

The schedule of pay rates and fire drills shall be as follows:

The compensation of the Fire Chief and Assistant Fire Chief shall be fixed at the rate of five dollars (\$5.00) per call and all other members of the Department shall be paid at the rate of two dollars (\$2.00) per call and the Department shall hold at least one fire drill each month.
