Sec. 7-1. Compliance with State Law.

General municipal elections for the Town shall be conducted in a manner pursuant to the provisions of the Code of Alabama, as amended, (For general election laws, see: Code of Alabama, Tit. 17, Sec. 1 et. seq.; For elections in general, see: Code of Alabama, Tit. 37, Sec. 34(20) - 34(72).)

Sec. 7-2. Candidate - Shall Specify Place for Candidacy.

A person qualifying as a candidate for the office of Town Councilman is hereby required to specify the place on the Council for which he is a candidate. No person shall be allowed to qualify as a candidate for more than one office on the Council. (Code of Alabama, Tit. 37, Sec. 34(22).)

Sec. 7-3. Elections - Designation of Positions on Town Council.

For the offices of Councilmen, the places on the Town Council shall be designated as follows:

- Place # 1 - Finance.
- Place # 2 - Utilities.
- Place # 3 - Streets.
- Place # 4 - Police and Fire.
- Place # 5 - Sanitation and Recreation.

Sec. 7-4. Elections - Notice.

The Mayor shall give notice of elections for Mayor and Council by publishing a notice in a newspaper published in the Town or, if no newspaper is published in the Town, by posting notices of such elections in three (3) public places in the Town. Notices of such elections shall be published on or before the third Tuesday in June preceding the election.

Sec. 7-5. Notice of Elections - Form.

The form of notice for general municipal elections shall be as follows:

Notice is hereby given that on (day of week), (date-month and year) an election for the purpose of electing a mayor and a town council for the Town of Ft. Deposit, Alabama, will be held, and that all registered and qualified electors of the State, who reside within the corporate limits of Ft. Deposit, Alabama, and have resided therein for three months or more immediately preceding the date of such election, will be authorized to participate in said election.
